	Community facilities Playgrounds, skate parks and outdoor gym equipment can be used.		Beauty services Cosmetic, nail, tanning and waxing salons can reopen. 1.5 metres between each set of client and staff receiving treatment.
	Cinemas, arcades and museums Can now reopen.		Rottneil Island Reopen to the WA general public.
