I.e., Smith dressage **OR** Smith dressage/breed **OR** Smith breed. Refunds will be provided up to the 21st August 2025 with a medical or vet certificate (to be received within 7 days of the event) less 20% of the fee paid.

**Riders to negotiate between events on the day. The program may be altered on the day.**

**Off the Track events** – please supply passport details in the space provided on the entry form.

**One rider per horse may get free entry to the show. All other vehicle occupants will be required to pay entry fees at the gate—*Off Lower John Street*. Parking in Cross Country Area ONLY**

## On Pony Club Grounds

Riders may choose 3 consecutive classes from classes 2 – 5  
ie: Classes 2,3,4 or Classes 3,4,5

1. 30-40cm Training round – Open to all riders (May be led). Start 8am – 9:30am. Only available BEFORE main jumping events --\$8 per round
2. 45cm Table C – Article 249.4 One round on time (each rail down equals 4 seconds added to time- two refusals allowed—just wasting time-3<sup>rd</sup> refusal-elimination)
3. 60cm Table C – Article 249.4 One round on time (each rail down equals 4 seconds added to time two refusals allowed—just wasting time-3<sup>rd</sup> refusal-elimination)
4. 70cm AM7 Article 245.3 & 238.2.2 (immediate jump off- if no faults in first round)
5. 80cm AM7 Article 245.3 & 238.2.2 (immediate jump off- ) if no faults in first round

FEES--\$15 per class ---Placings to 3<sup>rd</sup>
